Trinity 1965 Year Group

CONSTITUTION

- 1. The name of the group is Trinity 1965 Year Group.
- 2. The Group is a not-for-profit unincorporated association established by and for the benefit of its members. It is a separate body from Trinity College Cambridge and is run autonomously by its members.
- 3. Membership is open to all who matriculated at Trinity in 1965.
- 4. The object of the group is to maintain contact with the members themselves and with the College.
- 5. The Group shall be administered by a Committee of at least 6 members, including the following officers:
 - a. A chairman who shall chair meetings and resolve disputes in such way as he shall consider appropriate
 - b. A secretary who shall take minutes of meetings circulate them to the committee and deal with correspondence
 - c. A convener who shall arrange meetings and events
 - d. Such other officers as the Committee shall determine, particularly to ensure that adequate deputy support is catered for if and when required
- 6. Officers should hold office for 3 years if possible but not longer unless unavoidable.
- 7. Any member may raise any issue concerning the Group with the secretary.
- 8. Committee meetings may be held electronically or live.
- 9. For the purposes of The Data Protection Act all members agree that personal information they receive about other members will be kept securely in confidence unless expressly permitted otherwise and that the committee and the College may pass their contact details to other members except such details as they expressly exclude.
