## **Death of Napoleon**

Alasdair Darroch has sent us this story of his great great grandfather, Ensign Duncan Darroch [1800/1889] who was in the 20th Regiment on St Helena during the captivity of Napoleon.

He arrived on the Camel on 29th February 1820 and left shortly after the death of Napoleon in May 1821. Over that period, he wrote a number of interesting letters to his mother in Scotland recording the end of Napoleon's life, his death and the funeral, which he helped to arrange.

- Alexei Leonov of the USSR became the first man to walk in space
- UK's strategic missile (the TSR2) was cancelled
- Club 18-30 was launched in Lloret del Mar
- The average house price was £3,660! (and now.....?)
- Petrol was approx. 5.5 pence per litre in post decimal currency
- A pint of beer was approx. 8 to 9 pence equivalent in post decimal currency
- The death penalty was abolished in Britain
- The Post Office Tower was opened
- Myra Hindley and Ian Brady the "Moors murderers" were charged with the murders of several children
- Winston Churchill died
